Sai Krishna Public School is a CBSE affiliated institution in Chenkal, Neyyattinkara Taluk in the outskirts of Trivandrum district. The School is managed by Uday Educational and Charitable Trust. The school is providing a climate for wholesome and integrated upbringing of dynamic students well equipped with leadership traits not only in academics, but also in co-curricular as well as extra-curricular activities. We are trying to give them first hand experiences so that they can feel it and learn it by doing. It is hoped that this will help our students to meet the challenges of life with success and confidence.

### **International Recognition for Sai Krishna Public School**

### **SEETA (Student Education Enrichment Programme Through Adoption)**

SEETA is a programme launched in our school to enhance the standard of Education of students from financially backward families through sponsorship. Presently 15 students are given education through this program. The students coming under this program are given full free education including books, uniform and school fees.

### **ONGOING PROJECTS IN THE SCHOOL**

***“Hear and forget, see and remember, Do and understand”***. Cherishing this in mind we started exploring the un trodden paths.

### **SOAP MAKING**

Students learnt the art of soap making along with the marketing and sales strategies. Students are getting a real hand experience as they work through several assignments in groups and on their own. The products will be sold to the students and staff and nearby stores. The profit from soap making is also used for educating the needy .

### **VERMICOMPOST PLANT**

To make children aware about the need and importance of Organic Farming, we jumped into the exciting world of worm farming as it is a nutrient rich way of farming. A Vermicompost plant was installed under the supervision of the teachers of Dept.of Science. The manure got from vermicompost are used in organic farming.

### **Mushroom Cultivation**

Our school has started mushroom cultivation also and the demand for the mushroom is increasing day by day. The new venture involving 40 students is in full swing under the guidance of project co-ordinator Mrs. Sreekala. Around 8 kg of real mushroom is cultivated weekly and sold at a marginal price.

### **ORGANIC FARMING**

To promote the organic farming and to create an awareness in students about the need of cultivating crops that is pestfree, Our school resorted to the techniques of organic farming and this project was inaugurated by Mr.Ansalam, MLA, Neyyattinkara by planting the saplings. The aim of project was to provide chemical free, nutrient rich vegetables to the children and to provide them an opportunity to learn by doing. Spinach, cucumber, peas, lady's finger and plantain were cultivated through this organic farming.

### **PAPER BAGS**

'Say no to plastics and save life on earth. We started yet another project, making paper bags with a view of bringing awareness and instilling the thought of restoring the environment in students. The handmade paper bags were

distributed to the nearby stores and houses by our students and teachers and they tried their best to make the public aware of it through this effort.

### **PADDY CULTIVATION**

The school is maintaining one and half acres of land for the paddy cultivation. To instil the spirit of cultivating whatever we are in need of, we started cultivating the paddy fields. Till now, within a span of two years, we sowed the paddy seeds three times and did the harvest two times. The cultivation is still going on.
